Farrah Green has been closely involved with horses all of her life. Through high school and college, she competed in eventing, and won several area IX championships, from novice through preliminary level. After competing four years at the Intermediate level, and internationally at the One Star and Two Star Level, she decided to focus more on teaching and training. She participated in USDF, USEA, and Parelli Horsemanship Instructor courses. She taught horsemanship in 7 States and Canada for the last 25 years. In 2016, she took a course in Working Equitation course design, and has been helping create courses and educating competitors since.

Farrah also has a passion for Garrocha riding and she has performed internationally at horse fairs and exhibitions. On Saturday, she will work with each rider/ horse combination to introduce and/or improve on how to correctly ride the various obstacles that are used in the nationally recognized WE competitions. On Sunday, she will teach the art of Garrocha pole riding. Starting on foot she will teach each rider how to hold and use the traditional Garrocha pole, with the slow progression of ending the session on horseback utilizing the pole in various exercises to aid in harmonious riding and communication between horse and rider. Riders may participate in both days or sign up for just one day and auditors are welcome to watch free of charge.
